



# Swift Challenger 625 £16,633



It's well built, it's well styled, it's spacious enough to be well liked by large families – and there's a treat for the parents: a superb fixed bed. Added to all of that comes the benefit of twin-axle stability

**I**f you're looking for a six-berth caravan in which cooking is a pleasure, take a good look at the Challenger 625. The kitchen surface is huge; kitchen storage space is great, too. And the mains hotplate among the three gas burners will increase the interval between gas bottle changes.

The layout gives you plenty of options on sleeping and eating arrangements. Two can dine on the offside, four more at the front. You have two single beds at the front (with the alternative of a king-size double, of course), a single with a bunk above on the offside – and a lovely bedroom with en-suite and vanity arrangements alongside it. As a four-berth you can leave the side dining area in day-mode all the time, or keep the front as a permanent lounge.

**Light thoughts...**  
There's plenty of light by day but after dark we think you'll need a table lamp for reading

**Curtailed off...**  
The curtain that gives privacy to the offside bunk area folds away neatly into a slot here

**Light and bright...**  
The light, subtle tones of the upholstery look modern and bright – and there's no darkened privacy glass!

**Breakfast room...**  
Perfect for the first two to rise – they get the breakfast room!

**Shoes off, please!**  
This deep pile carpet is as tactile treat for your toes – a luxurious touch that's a distinguishing feature of this year's Challenger range. Be sure to take your shoes off to fully appreciate this carpet

**Wheel arch**  
This intrudes into the space under the table – so you'll need to check there's room for your feet



**Bedroom luxury**

Plenty of lockers, a large window, a deep, comfortable mattress... Is this the perfect caravan bedroom? It certainly comes pretty close. Judge for yourself...

**Well divided...**

The room divider gives you a place for mugs – plus extra kitchen surface that hinges down over the bed

**Well hidden...**

The table store forms part of the divider between bedroom and kitchen; it's small, neat and unobtrusive – yet sliding the table in and out is easy

**A cook's dream...**

When you have a work surface as large as this, making meals is a cinch

**Cool storage...**

There's a cupboard on each side of the fridge; the left one contains a cutlery drawer, the right one gives you deep shelving
